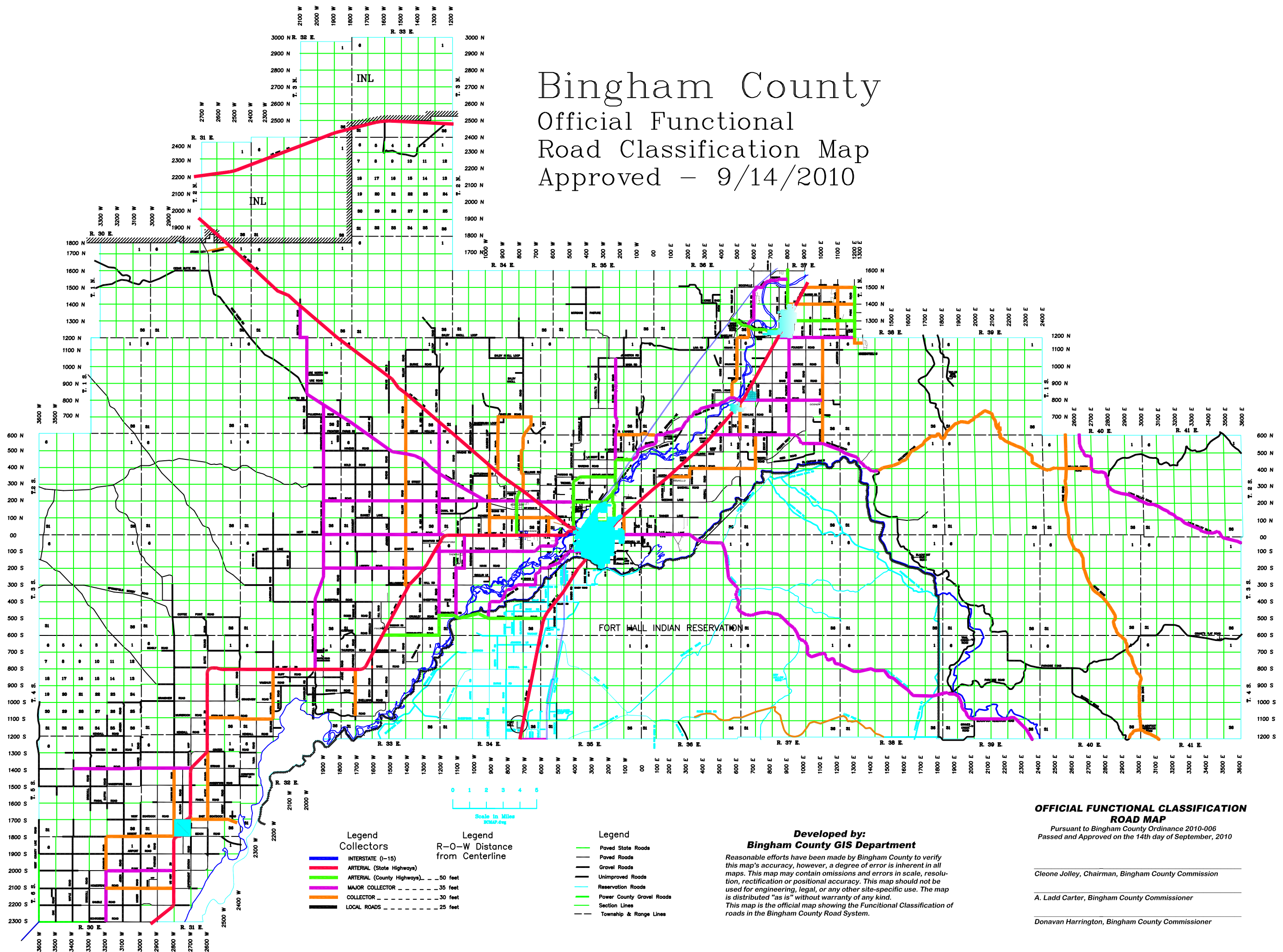


Bingham County Official Functional Road Classification Map Approved – 9/14/2010
