MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING




The Commissioners met with Elected Officials, Department Heads and Supervisors for the regular monthly staff meeting.

WEED DEPARTMENT

The Commissioners met with Dan Eldredge and Kraig Edwards, Weed Department to discuss the following: updates on equipment, seasonal sprayers, rental equipment, Noxious Weeds Trust, enforcement of noxious weeds, and chemicals.

After discussion the following was decided: There needs to be at least three bids for chemicals before making a purchase.

ELECTED OFFICIALS

The Commissioners met with Cleve Colson, Prosecuting Attorney; Sheriff Craig Rowland; Nate Satterthwaite, Human Resources Director; Ron Simmons, County Assessor; Pam Eckhardt, County Clerk; Tanna Beal, County Treasurer; Chase Hendricks, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney and Sadie Morrell (student observing the Prosecutor's Office) to discuss changes to the Employee Handbook. Mr. Colson explained that the reason the changes are needed due to the financial liability the excess PTO and Sick hours are to the county, managers having a hard time managing their employee's time off effectively and the high number of PTO hours individuals accrue. The changes are not to take anything away from the employees. The proposed changes were discussed. Human Resources will make the changes to the Employee Handbook, a meeting will be scheduled with all Elected Officials to review changes.

TAX DEED PROPERTY

The Commissioners met with Chase Hendricks, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney; Tanna Beal, County Treasurer; Pam Eckhardt, County Clerk and Fred K. Young, citizen regarding a tax deed property sold at public auction in 2015. The procedure to claim excess proceeds from the sale of a tax deed property was discussed. Mr. Young will be notified in June if there is any excess funds remaining after the interested parties are notified.



