Purpose of Class/Primary Function

The principal function of an employee in this class is to perform professional legal and administrative work involving criminal prosecutions, including misdemeanors, felonies and infractions. Assignments may be made to prosecute specific types of cases such as narcotics, sexual assault and abuse, property crimes, domestic violence, juvenile crime, or other specializations. Some civil work may be involved in advising County officials concerning legal issues such as medical indigency and child protection. The position may provide general direction to the Prosecuting Attorney's professional and clerical staff. The work is performed under the general supervision of the County Prosecuting Attorney and indirect supervision of a Chief Deputy Prosecutor, but latitude is granted for the exercise of independent judgment and initiative. The principal duties of this class are performed in a general office and courtroom environment.

Acceptable Experience and Training

- Graduation from a school of law accredited by the American Bar Association with a Juris Doctorate Degree;
- License to practice law in the State of Idaho;
- Experience in civil or criminal law is preferred; or
- Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the knowledge and abilities necessary to perform the work.
