Purpose Of Class/Primary Function

The primary function of an employee in this class is to perform herbicide and pesticide applications, cleanup, and basic maintenance of vehicles and spraying equipment. In addition, a seasonal employee is too perform other tasks, such as; Weed-eating and Mowing. The work is performed under the direct supervision of the Weed Superintendent or Weed Tech 2. The principal duties of this class are performed outdoors and may include working in adverse weather conditions and hazards involving the use of spraying equipment and hazardous chemicals, weed-eaters and mowing equipment.

This is a temporary, seasonal position, which may last up to eight months or less.

Acceptable Experience and Training

High school diploma or GED equivalency is required
Related work experience performing herbicide and/or pesticide application is preferred
Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the knowledge and abilities necessary to perform the duties and responsibilities of the classification
Jobs in this class require, with or without reasonable accommodation, lifting or moving up to 50 pounds frequently and up to 75 pounds occasionally. The employee is regularly required to stand; walk over rough or uneven ground, occasionally packing a backpack sprayer weighing 50lbs or more; sit for long periods of time; stoop, kneel, or crouch. The employee is frequently required to use hands to operate manual and powered tools and equipment; to handle or feel; to reach with hands and arms; and to climb or balance.
