ORDINANCE 86-4

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF SPEED LIMITS AND WEIGHT LIMITS FOR ALL TRUCKS AND BUSES DURING SUCH SEASONS AS THE BINGHAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY DEEM ADVISABLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF BINGHAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

SECTION 1: SHORT TITLE:

- (1) This ordinance shall be known as the Bingham County Frost Law Ordinance.

SECTION 2: AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE:

- (1) This ordinance is adopted pursuant to authority granted by Idaho Code Sections 31-714 and 49-906.

(2) The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a load limit per inch of tire width and a speed limit during such seasons as the county commissioners shall deem advisable. Weight shall not exceed 350 pounds per tire inch for all trucks and buses. Speed shall not exceed 35 miles per hour for all trucks and buses.

(3) Implementation of such speed and weight limits shall be set annually by the Bingham County Commissioners to protect county roads from spring deterioration and shall apply to county roads only.

SECTION 3: PENALTIES:


(1) It shall be unlawful and constitute a misdemeanor for any person to violate any portions of this ordinance.

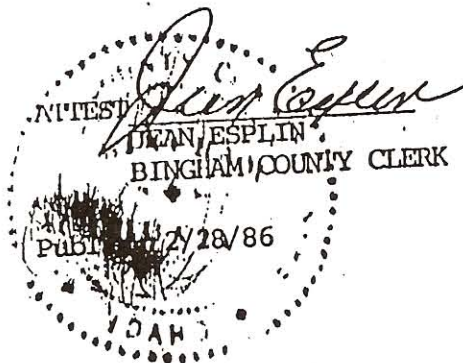
(2) Any person convicted of such violation shall be subject to punishment as prescribed by law.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE:

- (1) This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon publication.
