## BINGHAM COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2016-04

A FORMAL RESOLUTION SETTING SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEES FOR THE COUNTY OF BINGHAM, STATE OF IDAHO, EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 4, 2015.

**WHEREAS**, Bingham County is a political subdivision of the State of Idaho, organized under Idaho Code §31-3108, and is led by a Board of County Commissioners consisting of three (3) members who are duly elected and authorized to direct County business as authorized by law, (Idaho Code §§31-701 and 31-801);

**WHEREAS**, Bingham County may fund its solid waste operations through tax levy, user fees, current revenues, or a combination of all three pursuant to Idaho Code §31-4404;

**WHEREAS**, Bingham County pursuant to Idaho Code 31-870 may impose and collect fees for those services provided by the county which would otherwise be funded by ad valorem tax revenues. The fees shall be reasonably related to, but shall not exceed, the actual cost of the service being rendered.

**WHEREAS**, Bingham County Ordinance No. 2008-09 permits the Bingham County Commissioners to change solid waste disposal fees via resolution,

**WHEREAS**, on November 4, 2015, the Bingham County Commissioners met in open meeting and voted to increase the solid waste disposal fees for the disposal of tires in order to offset the increasing costs of waste disposal;

**THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners, Bingham County, Idaho, that:

1. Bingham County Resolution No. 2013-17, a Resolution Setting Solid Waste Disposal Fees for Bingham County be hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety by this current resolution.
2. **DEFINITIONS:**
  - a. **Bingham County Resident**—someone who has been domiciled in Bingham County for at least 30 days with the present intent of remaining in Bingham County.
  - b. **Disposal Sites**—Bingham County locations that accept waste, specifically known as the Bingham County Central Transfer Station, the Aberdeen Landfill/Transfer Station, and the Rattlesnake Landfill/Transfer Station.
  - c. **Municipal Solid Waste**—General, household waste that is not comprised of construction and demolition debris, dead animals, household appliances refrigeration or air conditioning units, tires, harmful liquids such as oil, paint, and antifreeze, burning barrels, inert/fill material, and tree branches.

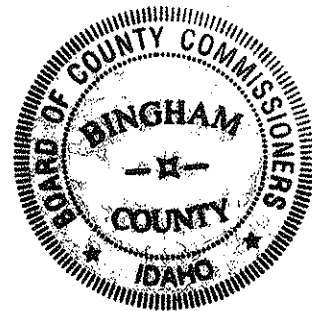
3. There will be no charge to Bingham County residents for the first five hundred pounds (500 lbs.) of each construction and demolition load brought to any of the disposal sites provided that the items are separated from the municipal solid waste (MSW). These construction and demolition items may be comprised of construction and demolition debris, grass, dead animals, and yard debris; excluding food grown on bushes, trees, and vines.
4. Compostable items that are deposited in designated areas are exempt from all charges, regardless of the weight or volume.
5. Additional fees may apply when unacceptable debris is brought to a facility or when debris is brought to an unacceptable facility.
6. The fee schedule is attached hereto as Schedule "1".
7. These fees will be effective as of the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 2015.
